

## Instructions for Cabin Fever Team Parent/Coaches

1. Please arrive 15 to 20 minutes before your scheduled game time. There will open courts available to warm your team up on. Games need to start on time to avoid delays in later games.
2. League parking is available in the rear parking lot at the high school. Enter the high school using the commons area rear entrance.
3. If your team can not make a scheduled game you must contact Steve Gilbert (477-2065 or cell 701-0214) at least 24 hours prior. This allows time to adjust the game day schedule.
4. Team jerseys and socks should all be of the same color. Teams should avoid wearing yellow jerseys to avoid confusion with referees. In cases when both teams have the same color jerseys the home will have to wear pinnes provided by the league.
5. Athletic or indoor soccer shoes that will not damage or mark the fieldhouse floor must be worn. Shoes must be clean and dry before entering the fieldhouse. This rule applies to spectators as well as players.
6. The tournament director or designee reserves the right to modify, reschedule, or cancel the games due to inclement weather.
7. All players **must wear shin guards**. Any player without shin guards will not be allowed to play.
8. Locker rooms will open, but access to areas of the school other than the main lobby and fieldhouse will not be allowed.
